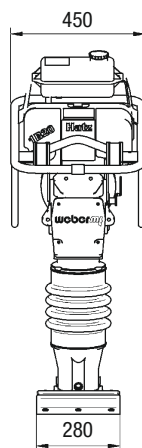
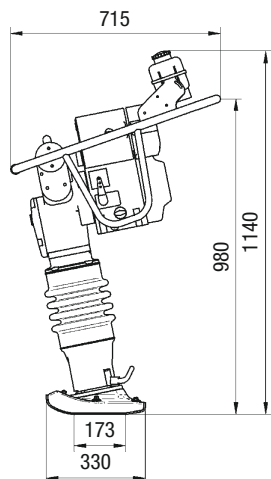
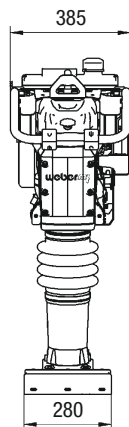
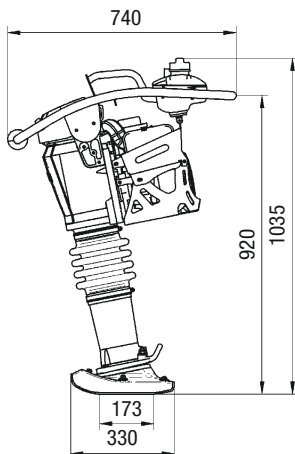
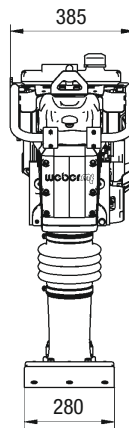
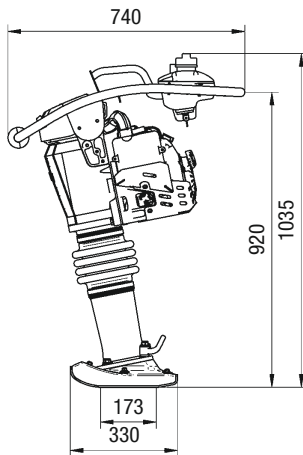
Additional features
